

- 2. From doing or performing any act contrary to or in contravention of the terms and conditions of the Articles of Incorporation and Articles of Faith and Bylaws of the Community Chapel and Bible Training Center as they existed on March 3, 1988; and
- 3. From destroying, damaging, removing, secreting, selling, or encumbering the files, records, notes, tape recordings or any other property, whether real or personal, belonging to the Community Chapel and Bible Training Center; and it is further
