Q Do you recall whether or not during the meeting where this letter was signed -- withdraw that.

Was the meeting where this letter was signed the same meeting where the previous two documents, the resolution to remove Donald Barnett as member of the board of directors, and the resolution to amend the bylaws, was that the same meeting, or was that all done at the same meeting?

- A I don't remember.
- 12 Q If you would look again at Exhibit Number 18, is the
 13 resolution to amend the bylaws that Exhibit Number 18
 14 indicates was discussed and adopted at 3:25 p.m. on
 15 March 4, 1988, is that the resolution set out in

- 17 A Fifteen?
- 18 Q Yes.

- Q Is the resolution to remove Donald Barnett as a member of the board of directors that Exhibit Number 18 indicates, the minutes of the meeting that occurred in the afternoon of March 4th at 3:15, that those minutes

I'd like to ask you to take a look at Exhibit Number 17, on page three, in the first full paragraph that is the second, well, a third of the way down the page, where it be begins with the words, This disfellowship is not contrary to any provision of our Articles of Incorporation or bylaws as currently amended.

Previous limitations in the bylaws to your dismissal have been removed by legally-adopted amendments as of today, end of quote.

In executing or signing Exhibit Number 17, was it your intention, by that language, to refer to the amendments to the bylaws that are reflected in Exhibit Number 15?

A Yes.

- Q In making or reaching your decision to disfellowship
 Donald Barnett, did you consider as the reason, or one
 of the reasons, that he had acknowledged having had
 sexual activity with other members of the
 congregation, women members of the congregation, other
 than his wife?
- A No, that wasn't the reason.
- Q What was the reason?
- A The reason was that he refused the remedy we offered him, to preclude anything like that from happening in the future.

- A I don't remember precisely, but it seemed to me that it was indefinite. I don't know that a time limit was put on it.
- Q The special status would involve him not being alone with a female member of the church; is that correct?
- A In private, yes.

- Q In private, and that could have gone on forever?

 MR. ROHAN: Objection, speculation.
- A Well, like I said, there was no time limit put in the letter.
- Q Was your word "indefinite"?
- A I don't remember. It was my intention to see that there was some improvement in his social decorum, that would authorize us to remove that whole status.
- Q At the time of the eldership hearings were you aware of any members of the eldership who were or had engaged in sexual activity with women, other than their wife?
- A No.
- You were not aware of any other members of the eldership, or those who were involved in holding the eldership hearings, who had engaged in any sort of

sexual activity with any other woman, other than his

A Yes, that's true.

MR. ROHAN: Asked and answered.

- Q Had you, at that point in time, engaged in sexual activity with any woman other than your wife, during the period of 1986, '87 or up until March 4th, 1988?
- A No.

- Q Was Donald Barnett, following your and your fellow senior elders disfellowshipping of him, given an opportunity to appeal his disfellowshipment?
- A Not in the letter. No, he wasn't.
- Q Was he given an opportunity to review his own disfellowshipment also?

MR. ROHAN: Objection, vague and ambiguous.

- A He was presented a copy of the letter.
- Q Was it the senior elders' intention, you, Mr. Hartley or Mr. Hicks, to permit him to review, and if he felt so inclined, reverse his disfellowshipment?

MR. ROHAN: Objection, calls for speculation.

- A I can tell you what was in my mind at the time.
- Q Okay.
 - A Had he, upon receiving that letter said, in order to avoid this, I will agree to your special status letter, if he had done that, then of course there

would have been no reason, in my mind, to disfellowship him. That was church policy.

- Q Had he been advised of that by you, or any member of the --
- A He knew the church policy.
- Q Did anybody specifically advise him of that?
- A I don't know.

- Q Did you discuss, or were you present during any discussion by the members of the Board of Senior Elders, or by the members of the eldership, of the possibility of presenting the decision whether to remove Donald Barnett as pastor of the Community Chapel and Bible Training Center to the congregation, did you ever hear that discussed?
- A No. You mean in the way of presenting it for a vote?
- Q Yes.
 - A No. That was not church policy.
 - Q It was not church policy to present to the congregation the decision whether or not to remove a pastor?
- A No.
 - Q Were you aware of a movement or desire by any elders or any persons attending Community Chapel and Bible Training Center during the year 1987, or early part of 1988, prior to the eldership hearings, though, to

the Community Chapel and Bible Training Center?

- A On a regular basis, yes. There are some of those others we see from time to time, but not on any regular basis.
- Q I believe, and correct me if I'm wrong, that you indicated that the meeting of the Board of Senior Elders that occurred on February 10th, the minutes for which are contained in Exhibit Number 7, and the meeting that of the Board of Senior Elders that occurred on February 26th, the minutes for which are contained in Exhibit Number 8, and the meeting --

MR. ROHAN: Tell us the question first, and then he can look at the documents, because he's trying to look through the documents, and it's hard for him to listen and look at the documents.

MR. JOHNSON: We'll withdraw that question for Counsel's benefit.

MR. ROHAN: Thank you.

- Q (By Mr. Johnson) There were three meetings that I believe you indicated Donald Barnett was not present at, meetings of the Board of Senior Elders, and they're the meetings of February 10th, February 26th and March 4th in the afternoon?
- A (Nods head affirmatively.)
- Q My question is, is it your belief that Donald Barnett

was advised that the members of the Board of Senior Elders were going to hold those meetings?

MR. ROHAN: Objection, asked and answered.

- A I don't remember.
- Q With regard to the meeting that occurred on the afternoon of March 4th, is it your understanding or belief, or was it your understanding or belief that he was advised or invited to participate in that meeting?

MR. ROHAN: Objection, asked and answered.

- A I said I don't remember.
- Q Prior to February of 1988, had you attended meetings of the members of the Board of Senior Elders of the Community Chapel and Bible Training Center?

MR. ROHAN: Prior to what date?

MR. JOHNSON: Prior to February of 1988.
