

1 When they refused to cooperate and answer my questions, I saw that
2 nothing could be gained from further discussions and I asked them
3 to leave. There never was any mention of amending the Articles or
4 Bylaws. There was no indication made at that time that this was to
5 be considered a meeting of the Board of Directors. No indication
6 was made that this gathering was to be adjourned to a later time or
7 place. There simply was no discussion of anything that these
8 individuals or the Board of Directors was going to do in the future.

9 I have over a number of years relied upon the representations
10 of the defendants that I did have the authority that had been
11 provided to me. In fact, I deeded my house (the present parsonage)
12 to Community Chapel based upon the representations that I would be
13 able to reside in the Parsonage as the Pastor and that I would be
14 the Pastor. My equity in that house was transferred to Community
15 Chapel. I gave up any interest in any other work to act as the
16 Pastor of Community Chapel. There is no other livelihood that I
17 have and I have not pursued any other careers based upon the fact
18 that I was to have the authority as the Pastor and to represent the
19 members of the congregation as their Pastor in the future.

20 These defendants have consistently executed Bylaws
21 giving me authority over the religious areas of Community Chapel.
22 This included my various positions involving the Bible College, the
23 Church, the Christian School, etc.

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DECLARATION OF
DONALD BARNETT -

1 The defendants have a difference in religious principles from
2 myself and other members. If there was not a difference, there
3 would not have been any action by taken by the defendants in this
4 litigation.


5 The defendants Hartley and DuBois would benefit from my
6 removal because they would be able to espouse religious principles
7 that are contrary to the principles of myself and members of the
8 congregation.

9 Pursuant to the Bylaws, I have had one independent power and
10 that is to adjust the salaries of employees. Any control over the
11 defendants' salaries would be removed by the actions of the
12 defendants.

14 penalty and perjury in the laws of the State of Washington that the
15 foregoing is true and correct.
