I am taking the liberty of drawing to your attention the bylaws revisions which we worked on in December, January, and February. These are the changes which would sever the satellite churches' legal ties to our corporation.

I feel that the issue is still valid and the attorney's advice still stands, in spite of all that has transpired since the end of February. The issue is: having the corporation legally disentangle itself from the satellites to avoid liability for lawsuits against satellites. Although I don't have specifics, I heard that even recently more threats against satellites have been made.

I am bringing this matter to your attention at this time with hopes that would be possible for the three Senior Elders to agree that this issue is still a valid one and that, in the interest of the corporation, it would be good to sign in these changes immediately.

You have somewhere in your possession a marked-up review copy reflecting in detail all the changes between the existing bylaws and the attached version. If you can't find it, I'll be glad to send you another one. If you can sign this document, then please do so and return it to me, and I will run it by Jack and Scott. Thanks, Don.
